**Lord, have mercy upon us.** (silence)

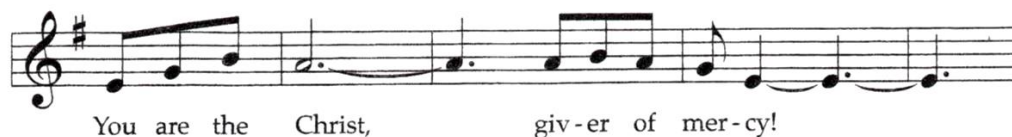
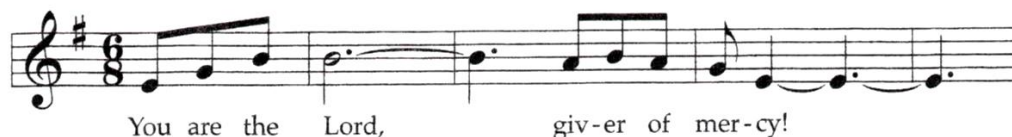
